Maintenance: The new maintenance personnel have been busy working on potholes, grass mowing and repairing equipment.

Streets: NDDOT representatives were in town to inspect the streets and provide an assessment of their condition. Their opinion was that chip sealing would not be a cost-effective investment at this time. Instead, they recommended that the streets be repaired. A special meeting will be held on June 15 to review the survey results related to the street project.

Windows: Motion by Kottre, seconded by Fitterer, to replace the remaining seven windows at the City Auditorium at a cost of \$11,826, with the work to be completed by Leingang Home Center. Motion carried unanimously.

Insurance – Policy Renewal and Coverage Changes: Motion by Swanson, seconded by Fitterer, to renew the NDIRF insurance policy through the Morman Agency with a \$2 million liability limit and no public sewer back-up and water main break coverage under endorsement #GL2050. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Swanson, seconded by Kottre, to delete the following items from the Inland Marine policy: 1971 Elgin Sweeper, NH Mower, IHC Farmall 404, IHC Farmall 2656, Concrete/Asphalt Saw, Sander and to remove full coverage from the 7×14 enclosed trailer and the 2011 GMC Sierra pickup. Motion carried unanimously.
