

Regular Meeting of the Glen Ullin City Council
July 13, 2026

Mayor Doug Martwick called the meeting to order at 6:30pm in the Council Chambers with the Pledge of Allegiance. Council members present: Wayne Fitterer, Preston Foss, Wade Kottre, and Brent Swanson, Absent: Kevin Emter and Chasity Wood. Also present: Deputy Myers, Jesse Wetzel, N Bittner, B Stephan and V Horst.

Election: Moved by Fitterer, seconded by Foss to cast a unanimous ballot to retain the current slate of officers, President-Brent Swanson, Vice President-Chasity Orcutt. Motion carried unanimously.

Consent Agenda: Moved by Swanson, seconded by Foss to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Chipseal Project: Moved by Swanson, seconded by Kottre to accept the bid from Astec Corp. for 2 projects with the low bid of \$289,080. Motion carried unanimously.

Project #1 14 blocks double chip seal, 6 blocks single chip seal \$134,640

Project #2 19.5 blocks double chip \$154,440

115 N Ave W: Curb stop needs repairs. A second sewer line on the property does not appear to be connected to the main; further research will be conducted. Moved by Swanson, seconded by Foss, to charge an annual fee of \$144 when connected for the second sewer line. Motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance:

- Omega mix: Moved by Swason, seconded by Foss to purchase another load. Motion carried unanimously.
- Auditorium Door: The lock/panic bar will be repaired by maintenance.
- Crushed Asphalt: No more sales
- Well House: Needs new plumbing
- Cattails at the lagoon need to be sprayed

Deputy: Will watch for illegal parking. No other issues to report.

Resolution 2026-4: Moved by Kottre, seconded by Swanson to approve this resolution granting funds up to \$5,000 per building for up to 3 buildings per year for residents removing dilapidated buildings. Motion carried unanimously.

Garbage Rates: Moved by Swanson, seconded by Foss, to increase garbage rates by 10% due to fuel surcharges. Motion carried unanimously.

Pumphouse Water Rate: Moved by Swanson, seconded by Fitterer to increase the cost of water from \$15.00 to \$19.00 per 1,000 gallons due to rising operating costs. Motion carried unanimously.

Preliminary Budget: Moved by Swanson, seconded by Kottre to increase the property tax by the maximum allowed and allocate \$50,000 to a street project fund to serve as a savings account for future street work. Motion carried unanimously.

Transfer: Moved by Swanson, seconded by Foss, to move \$30,000 from the general fund to the auditorium fund to cover the cost of the flooring and final plumbing expenses. Motion carried unanimously.

120 South Ave E: Mr. Fitterer will remove the fan that is hanging outside the building. Thank you, Mr. Fitterer.

Landfill: Council discussed landfill hours and possible improvements. No changes will be implemented at this time.

Adjourn: Moved by Kottre, seconded by Foss to adjourn the meeting at 8:45pm. Motion carried unanimously.
