

Transient Merchants Application

8.0201 Definitions: “Transient merchant” includes any person, individual, co-partnership or corporation, either as principal or agent, who engages in, does or transacts any temporary or transient business in the City of Glen Ullin, either in one locality, or in traveling from place to place within the City selling goods, wares and merchandise, who does not intend to become and does not become a permanent merchant of the City of Glen Ullin, and who, for the purpose of carrying on such business, hires, leases, occupies or uses a building, structure, lots, tract, railroad car or motor vehicle for the exhibition and sale of such goods, wares and merchandise. The person, individual, co-partnership or corporation so engaged shall not be relieved from complying with the provisions of this article merely by reason of associating temporarily with any local dealer, trader, merchant or auctioneer, or by conducting such transient business in connection with, as a part of, or in the name of any local dealer, trader, merchant or auctioneer.

8.0202 License Required

It shall be unlawful to do business in the City as a transient merchant without having first secured a license therefore as is herein provided. For the purpose of this article, any merchant engaging or intending to engage in business as a merchant in the City for a period of time not exceeding 100 days shall be considered as a transient merchant.

8.0203 License Fee

The license fee to be required of all transient merchants for the transaction of such business within the City is hereby fixed at the sum of \$100.00 per day for each and every day during which any such transient merchants shall transact business in the City. For temporary food vendors serving prepared foods, the license fee shall be \$20.00 per day. Food vendors must submit written permission from the landowner for where the vendor will be locating, shall not set up within 400 feet of an operational restaurant, and must have a permit from the ND Health Department. Food vendors who are part of a local volunteer, charity, or other public-spirited organization shall be excluded from the licensing provisions of this Chapter upon approval of the City Council. ¹²⁻¹¹⁻
